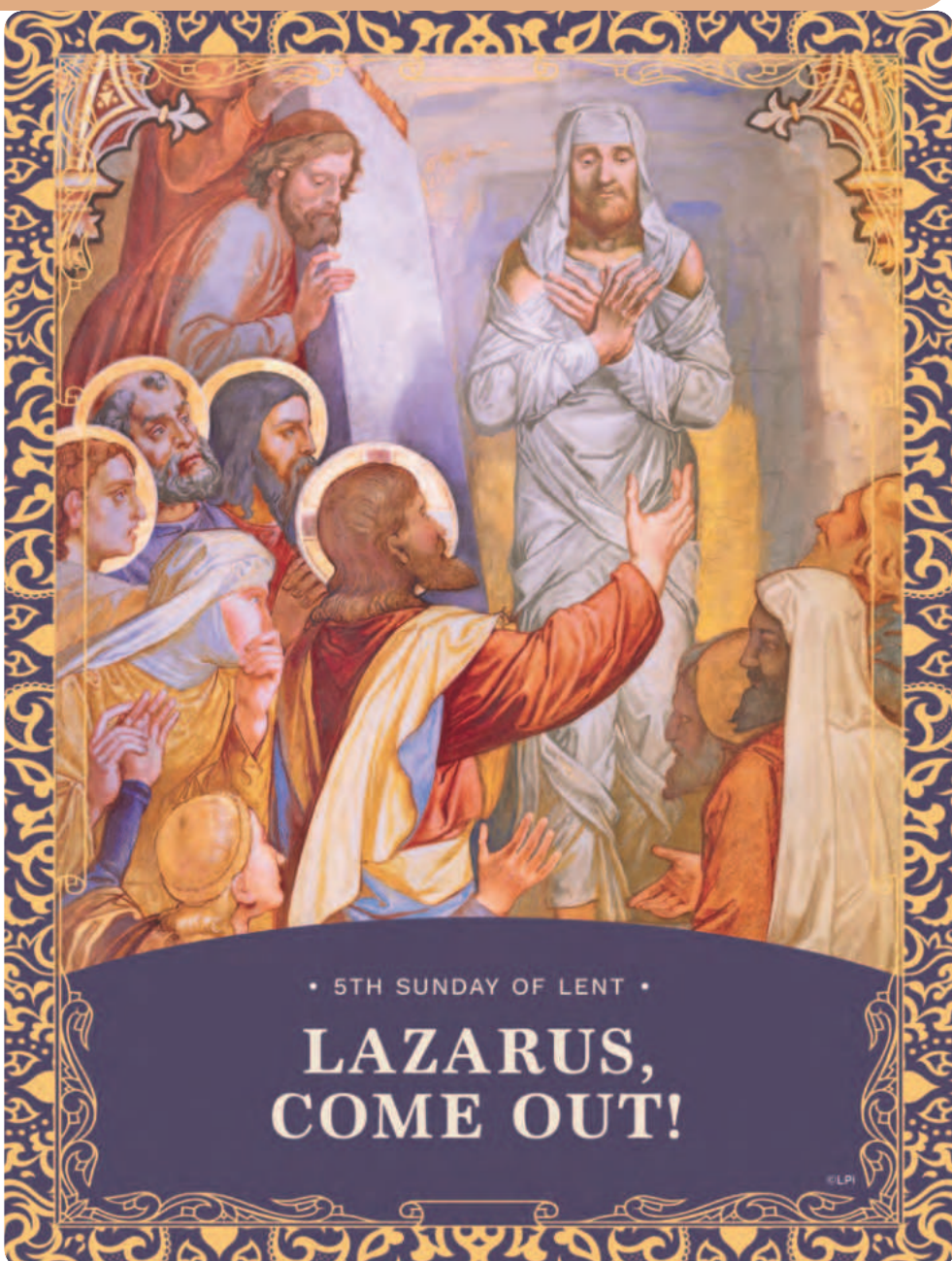

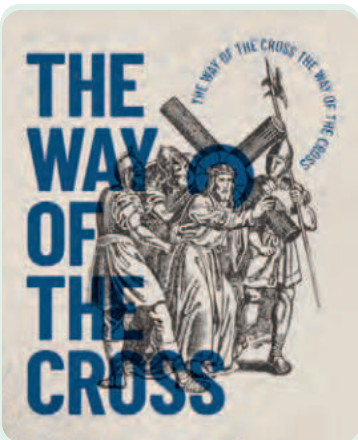

The maximum QCR credit donation amount for 2025 is \$495 single filer or \$987 married filing jointly. There is no minimum.

AZ law allows QCO donations made from 1/1/2026 through 4/15/26 to be claimed on the 2025 income tax return using AZ Form 321.
